Itinerary

A summary of the amazing sights we will explore each day:

Day 1 - Upon your arrival at Cairo airport, our representative will meet and assist your transfer.

Day 2 - Memphis, the first capital of ancient Egypt. We will visit the colossal statue of King Ramses II, as well as the famous Alabaster **Sphinx**. Not far from there is the necropolis of Saqqara, where are the ruins of the pyramid of King Zoser, the first pyramid built, and the **Serapeum**, a necropolis of gigantic sarcophagi; dedicated to the sacred bull Apis. We will visit the Pyramid of **Ounas** where the texts of the pyramids are inscribed, and after the **Red Pyramid**, **Bent Pyramid**, and **Black Pyramid** at Dahshur.

Day 3 - The legendary **Giza plateau**. We will visit the pyramids of Cheops, Khephren and Mykerinus. We will then visit the mythical Grand Sphinx. The tour also includes a visit to the Valley Temple, which is part of the Khephren Complex.

We will visit the remaining major remains of Heliopolis, the obelisk of the temple of Ra-Atum, erected by Senousret I of the XII dynasty. He is still in his original position, now in Heliopolis north of Cairo.

Visit Ben Ezra Synagogue in ancient Cairo, where the daughter of Pharaoh would have collected Moses in his basket, and that he would have grown in these same places.

We will also visit the church suspended on the columns of ruins of the fortress of Egypt-Babylon, where the sacred family hid from the Romans.

Day 4 - The pyramid at Meidum is the second pyramid built after Djoser's and may have been originally built for Huni, the last pharaoh of the Third Dynasty, and was continued by **Sneferu**. The architect was a successor to the famous **Imhotep**.

Day 5 - While sailing the Nile we will discover its mysterious nature and the glory of the Ancient Egyptian Life interwoven with the beauty of nature; river breezes, radiant sun, sparkling constellations, and glowing moonlight. Mysterious Egyptian beauty can be completely experienced as we explore the contrast between the Blue, Yellow and Green Egypt.

Day 6 - Today we start on the eastern bank of the Nile on the site of **Beni Hassan**, then visit the necropolis of **Tuna El-Gabal** and **Al-Ashmunien** (the ancient city of **Hermopolis**)

Day 7 - Tel El Amarna; the capital of **Akhenaton**. We will discover the necropolis of the nobles, and the royal necropolis; Aton is a solar god from ancient Egypt. He is best known as an ephemeral god of the Egyptian mythology of the New Kingdom during the reign of Amenhotep IV who took the name of Akhenaton.

Day 8 – On to the city of **Abydos**, the main cult center of the god **Osiris**, the god of the underworld. We will visit the temple of **Seti I**, considered the most beautiful temple in Egypt.

Day 9 – In **Dendara** Visit **Hathor Temple**, the goddess of love, music and dancing. We will then begin sailing to Luxor.

Day 10 – In **Luxor** we will start our adventure with a visit to the Necropolis of **Thebes**, Valley of the Kings, the temple of Queen Hatshepsut, passing by the Valley of the Queens, the Nobel Tombs, the Colossi of Memnon, and the Temple of Habu. Later in the evening, we will explore the glory of Karnak, the biggest temple on earth, then on to Luxor Temple.

Day 11 - In **Esna** (Latopolis), we will visit the temple of **Khnum**. The city was known as Lunyt or Ta-senet to the Ancient Egyptians. Then we sail on to visit the Temple of Edfu.

Day 12 - We visit the temple of Gebel El-Silsila, where we will discover the rock-cut temple of Hormoheb and the famous sandstone quarries in ancient Egypt. We continue to Meniha Island to enjoy a barbecue dinner with drums and folk music around a campfire.

Day 13- We will explore the extraordinary temple of **Kom Ombo**. The temple was built in symmetry; two entrances, two halls and two sanctuaries dedicated to the Falcon God Haroeris (Horus the Elder) and the Crocodile God Sobek.

Day 14 – In **Aswan**, a boat trip to the romantic temple of Philae, dedicated to the goddess Isis. Then a visit to the Nubian village, starting in Felucca of Elephantine Island, we end with the granite quarry and look at the impressive unfinished Obelisk of Hatshepsut. Sunset chilling at the terraces of Old Cataract.

Day 15 – The temples of **Abu Simbel** dug into the rock in Lake Nasser "the Nubian Sea". Built by Pharaoh Ramses II (-1304 / -1213, XIXth Dynasty) to commemorate his victory at the Battle of Qadesh, they were destined for his worship as well as that of Egyptian gods and his wife Nefertari.
